

QUIET STUDY ROOM USE

MacDonald Public Library strives to provide a variety of spaces that facilitate different learning styles and research and study needs.

Individuals may use the two independent study rooms on a first come first serve basis, based upon room availability. Please adhere to the following rules while in the quiet study area:

- Rooms are to be utilized for quiet independent study. Quiet Study is defined as studying for tests, working on individual projects, or quiet reading.
- One on one discussion, conducting or running a business, for profit tutoring are not permitted.
- No audible cell phone use is permitted in the rooms, if necessary; phone calls can be made / taken in the outer lobby.
- Utilize earbuds/headphones with media devices. *The library does not provide earbuds or headphones.*
- Individuals engaging in activities that are unsuitable for the public spaces or in violation of the rules will forfeit their privilege.
- Library staff retains the right to monitor study room use and will have free access to study rooms at all times.
